We are told today, amid the programmed joyous cries of Iraqi election success by the highest Iraqi and American leaders, that 66-70% of the Iraqi registered voters actually voted yesterday.

Since there were a reported 14+ million registered voters, we must assume that about 8 million of them did vote.
